- All non elucidated crimes and/or deaths...(i.e.: dead unidentified bodies discoveries, etc.)

Data entry method:

When a commune is named:

- The location itself and a range of 30 to 50 km should be considered.

When no numbers given in an incident (i.e.: "several"):

- The number "3" is recorded.

Security Forces includes:

- Police, Gendarmerie Nationale, Algerian National and Popular Army (ANP), armed patriots-GLD's (Groupe Légitime Défense)

Abducted civilians or Security Forces members:

- 50% accounted for dead (statistically, abducted people have been found dead within the next few days after the incident)

Wounded terrorists:

- 50% of all reported wounded terrorists in a direct fire exchanges have been accounted as "captured".

Incidents involving explosives (of all kinds):

- "1" refers to one incident involving explosives and not the number of explosive devices detonated/discovered or disarmed.

The criminal court of Algiers Court sentenced two Moroccan nationals to five years in prison and fined them 100 000 dinars each (\$9000) for terrorist association . One a former Moroccan soldier was recruited from a mosque in the Moroccan capital where he had made contact with a Moroccan terrorist network. Both men had been captured in Tizi Ouzou in August 2008.

Seven terrorists were killed in Djefla in the early hours of the morning by the army, Special Forces had been sweeping the region these past two weeks following an armed group after they had received information of suspicious movement in the region The security forces finally set an ambush killing all seven terrorists and recovered their weapons in a wooded area in the region of Charef 50Km's from Djefla. Security forces stated they believe the armed groups have been redeploying to the region and are well armed. The region is located on a mountain range bordering the regions of Laghouat and Djefla.

Three others received sentences ranging from seven to three years for their part in several bomb attacks kidnappings and murders and their involvement in attacks against the state, locations they had targeted were the Police headquarters in Delly's east of Algiers, the kidnapping of a bar man in Tizi Ouzou and the murder of a prison guard who was present in the bar when the abduction took place.

On Wednesday night in Tizi Ouzou Security forces opened fire on a group of GSPC as they approached the village of Imessounène on the outskirts Iflissen, Timezrit after tracking them through the night, a fire fight ensued for thirty minutes between the armed group and the armed forces. The armed group fled into the local forest of Aberane where they were encircled, at 04:00am another exchange of fire erupted, security forces confirmed killing one terrorist whose body was recovered at the scene but believe they had killed a second but his body was carried off by his accomplices one terrorist was captured and one assault rifle was recovered.

A vast sweep operation is ongoing in the regions of Bouira, Bejaia, Bordj Bou Arreridj and Setif. Security forces backed by Patriots and communal guards have been searching these areas for over a week. In the region of Bejaia a patrol of Municipal guards killed two terrorists , a group of Communal guards killed one terrorist and wounded another following a surveillance operation after coming across the armed groups makeshift camp, six others one who had been wounded escaped. Weapons, grenades, mobile telephones and other important documents were recovered from the scene. This had led the security forces to believe they have killed an important high ranking member of AQIM. The regions were security forces are continuing the ongoing sweep operations are reported to be transit areas and hubs for AQIM members operating with in the region or terrorist groups fleeing from the military pressure recently inflicted on them.

Five members of a terrorist support network connected to the GSPC were arrested by security forces in Boumerdes. Those arrested have all been placed in custody by the prosecutor at the court of Boumerdes under the charges of membership of a terrorist group, supporting a terrorist organisation and condoning crimes. The security services recovered subversive documents and CD's containing information about the GSPC and Al-Qaeda promoting violence. All those arrested and charged were from the regions of Thénia, Zemmouri, Sidi-Daoud and Bordj some had previously been sentenced in cases involving terrorism and served time in jail.

One soldier was killed and five others were wounded in a double bomb attack on the outskirts of Boumerdes near to Dellys yesterday afternoon. The incident took place at 13hr in Tissera east of Delly's in the commune of Afir .The wounded were cared for in a military medical institution before being transferred to a specialised centre in Algiers, The body of a slain soldier was sent to the morgue of a hospital in the region. The two explosions occurred almost simultaneously. The devices had been buried underground near a football field and had been operated remotely, according to news sources all of the soldiers were not in uniform and were believed to be playing football at the time. Local sources claimed two devices had been found in the same area two days previously. Security forces stated the men had probably been under surveillance from a terrorist group and were known to use the ground while off duty.

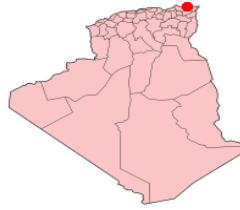

Following several unsuccessful attempts to force them to surrender the security services stormed the building killing all three men, Kalashnikov rifles, two pistols, a pair of binoculars and subversive documents were recovered. One of the terrorists was identified as an Emir close to the organisations leader Droukdel. He had reportedly been responsible for recruiting and training suicide bombers in the region.

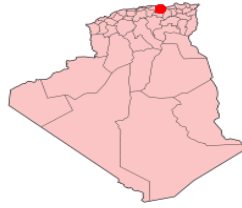

The chief of Algeria's national Police force, Ali Tounsi, was shot dead in his headquarters office by a member of his taskforce. The shooter attempted to commit suicide after killing the police chief, he was taken to hospital suffering from a gunshot wound and remains in custody. A judicial inquiry into the circumstances of the shooting has been opened. There has been no indication of a link to Islamist militants, and the incident was not motivated by any political or internal feud. Col Tounsi was one of Algeria's most powerful security officials and was closely involved in the country's fight against terrorism.

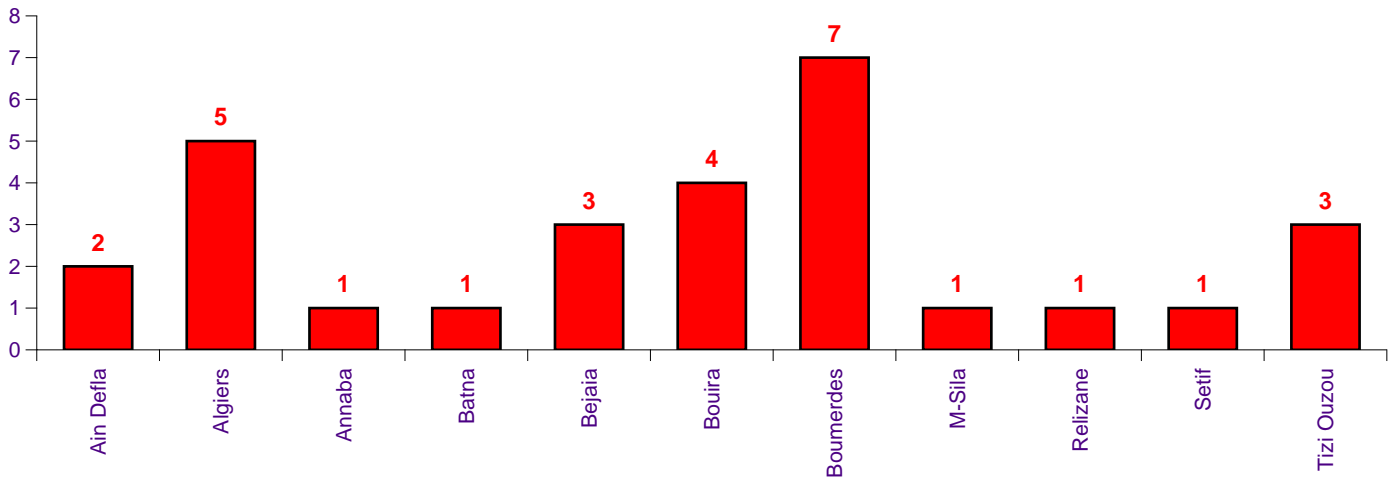
